INSTRUCTIONS:

The Franklin Township JFK Democratic Club is sponsoring up to three grants in the amount of \$1000.00 each. The Scholarship fund is part of our effort to give back to the Franklin community and is not affiliated with a political agenda. The scholarship is given in memory of two outstanding educators of Franklin Township who were also life-long community servants. It is for this reason the scholarship favors, but is not limited to, those wishing to be involved with education and service to the community.

Who may apply?

The scholarships are intended for two seniors graduating from Franklin Township High School who aspire to be educators, or, are planning careers in public service.

What is required?

The applicant must submit an unofficial high school transcript, a resume, two letters of recommendation and an essay of no more than 500 words. The applicant must also be available to read his or her essay at a luncheon honoring the recipients on Sunday, June 24, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. which will be held at the Ecco Bistro. (presenting the essay is an important condition of the scholarship).

What is the topic of the essay?

The topic of the essay is: **Discuss one school activity, class, community activity, or experience that most contributed to your personal growth. Please describe it in detail, including its significance or importance in your life and in the lives of others.**

How will the Committee judge your application?

The application will be judged on completeness, presentation, quality of the essay, evidence of school/community service, and academic achievement. Interviews will be held in early June.

When is the deadline for submitting the application?

Applications need to be submitted to the guidance office no later than June 1, 2012.
